

OHS for Managers and Supervisors One Day Extension Course

Learning outcomes

- outline their role and responsibilities as a manager or supervisor
- determine, implement and monitor OHS control measures
- understand how the skills of consultation, active listening, issue resolution may be used to achieve the OHS and RTW objectives of the manager/supervisor role
